The competition addresses young pianists of the age from 6 to 12 years.

Deadline for registration is January 31st 2019.

AWARDS / RATING:

Awards with a total value of 1.000 € are granted. For outstanding performance a Grand Prix (sum of money) can be awarded, as well as the admittance to the program „IMS Podium“ for outstanding young artists. This program includes e.g. further support of the musical development, public performances and concert tours. More information about „IMS Podium“ can be found here (in German only at the moment):

Further placements in the competition will be rated by a number of points by the jury, awards in form of gift vouchers will be granted. A payment in cash of these vouchers is not possible.

The jury decides over the numbers and levels of awards. Special awards are possible.

Selected awardees and participants will perform at the closing concert. All participants receive a participation certificate. There will be a childrens jury awarding one „childrens award“ per category.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The piano competition for young pianists is executed by the International Music School Berlin
- The competition is open to public.
- Eligible are pianists born after March 23rd 2006.
- Participants who have received less than one year of musical instruction at the time of the competition will be considered specially.
- The competition takes place at the concert hall of the intercultural center “Familien-RING“, Selerweg 17, 12169 Berlin.
- The order of the participants public performances will be defined in advance by the following procedure: The first candidate will be chosen by lot. All further candidates will play in subordinated alphabetical order.
- For category I the program is free of choice, duration 3 to 5 minutes.
- Category II should perform at least two titles of different character, duration 7 to 10 minutes.
- A recital by heart is desirable for both categories, but not mandatory.
- If performance time is exceeded, the jury has the right to interrupt the performance.
- **Performance will include: short introduction (name, program), performance, short talk with the jury.**
- On March 23rd the performances of the candidates take place, on March 24th 2019 there will be the closing event with the announcement of the awardees. All participant should be presents at the accouncement of the results.
- At the closing event a short, individual talk with the jury can be held upon prior agreement.
- The judgement/rating of the jury is final and not controvertible.
- The legal guardians allow the promoter (IMS Berlin) to take fotos, sound- and videorecordings of the participants during the whole competition and to use these recordings in public (e.g. website of the school) for the purpose of documentation.

- **Registration fee is 20,- €.** The registration fee will not be reimbursed, also not if participation is prevented by force majeure.
- Your registration will be effective after the successful transfer of the registration fee. You'll receive payment information after the timely receipt of your application.
- With their registration the participants and their legal guardians agree to the terms and conditions of the competition.
- Participation can be cancelled any time without reason after successful registration. The registration fee however will not be reimbursed.
- The completed registration form must be submitted until **January 31st 2019**.
- Number of participants is limited.
- The exact schedule of the competition will be announced mid to end of February 2019.
