The competition addresses young violinists of the age from 6 to 12 years.

Deadline for registration is January 31st 2020.

AWARDS / RATING:

Awards with a total value of 1.000 € are granted. For outstanding performance a “Grand Prix” (sum of money) can be awarded, for the youngest outstanding violinist a “Debut” prize is awarded.

Besides this the admittance to the program „IMS Podium“ for outstanding young artists can be awarded to the winners of “Grand Prix” and “Debut” prizes. This program includes e.g. further support of the musical development, public performances and concert tours. More information about „IMS Podium“ can be found here (in German only at the moment):

The jury decides over the numbers and levels of awards. Further placements in the competition will be rated by a number of points by the jury. Special awards are possible. Selected awardees and participants will perform at the closing concert. All participants receive a participation certificate. There will be a childrens jury awarding one „childrens award“ per category.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- The violin competition for young violinists is executed by the International Music School Berlin
- The competition is open to public.
- Eligible are violinists born after March 22nd 2007.
- Participants who have received less than 1 year of musical instruction at the time of the competition will be considered specially.
- The competition takes place at the International Music School Berlin, Eisenacher Str. 49, 10823 Berlin.
- The order of the participants public performances will be defined in advance by the following procedure: The first candidate will be chosen by lot. All further candidates will play in subordinated alphabetical order.
- For category I (6-9 years) the program should contain at least two titles of different character, duration max. 10 minutes.
- Category II (10-12 years) should perform one Etude and at least one title free of choice, duration max. 15 minutes.
- !! An exact duration of the program has to be announced with the registration !!
- A recital by heart is mandatory for both categories.
- If performance time is exceeded, the jury has the right to interrupt the performance.
- On March 21st the performances of the candidates take place, on March 22nd 2020 there will be the closing event with the announcement of the awardees. All participant should be present at the announcement of the results.
- At the closing event a short, individual talk with the jury can be held upon prior agreement.
- The judgement/rating of the jury is final and not controvertible.

- A short, individual time for warming up onsite on the day of competition performances (March 21st 2020) will be granted in advance. No further rooms can be provided for preparation before or during the competition.
- The legal guardians allow the promoter (IMS Berlin) to take fotos, sound- and videorecordings of the participants during the whole competition and to use these recordings in public (e.g. website of the school) for the purpose of documentation.
- **Registration fee is 35,- €.** The registration fee will not be reimbursed, also not if participation is prevented by force majeure.
- Your registration will be effective after the successful transfer of the registration fee. You'll receive payment information after the timely receipt of your application.
- With their registration the participants and their legal guardians agree to the terms and conditions of the competition.
- Participation can be cancelled any time without reason after successful registration. The registration fee however will not be reimbursed.
- The completed registration form must be submitted until **January 31st 2020**.
- Number of participants is limited.
- The exact schedule of the competition will be announced mid to end of February 2020.
